Don Hackney and T. D. Austin made a presentation to the Council regarding cable television. There was some discussion regarding a franchise; however, no decision was made.



Bids for a police car was tabled until after April.




Howard Paul Stegall made a motion to declare the results of the April 5th City Council election official. Gary Hatfield seconded the motion. All in favor.

All salaried employees should receive a 10% increase


